Engineering - parts of machines that have to work in time.

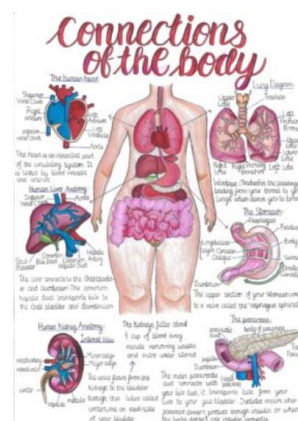
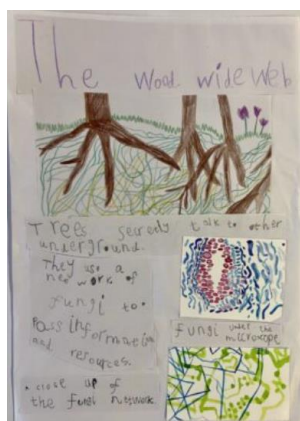
### Making your poster

- On either A3 or A4 paper
- 2d (flat) - if you make a model please take a photo and send that in as your entry.
- You can use materials such as pens, pencils, scissors, glue, watercolours, paint, colouring crayons, pipe cleaners, felt, thread, wool, foil, clay, string, beads, stamps, foam pompoms.
