

Kinder Scout Summit

Sponsored Walk

17th September 2016

To raise money and awareness for the newly founded charity Gold September, in memory of Eddy Parry, we have organised a sponsored walk for the children and anyone else who would like to come along.



The walk is to the summit of Kinder Scout, Derbyshire's highest peak and should take around 5 hours. Kinder Scout is a Moorland Plateau and National Nature Reserve in the Dark Peak of the Derbyshire Peak District in England. Part of the moor, at 636 metres (2,087 ft.) above sea level, is the highest point in the Peak District, the highest point in Derbyshire and the highest point in the whole of the East Midlands.

Meeting on the 17th September at 10:00am ready to set walking at 10:30am the walk will take-in the following sights: Lower Edale, Jacobs Ladder, Punch's Nose, Noe Stool Stone and finally the summit. From the summit, on a clear day, one can see great views over the surrounding countryside as far as Manchester!

CLOTHING & EQUIPMENT

We advise you to bring a good Packed Lunch, plenty of Snacks and plenty to drink.

We suggest you wear Walking Boots/Shoes or very sturdy Trainers and a good pair of Walking Socks. In addition, a Waterproof Jacket & Trousers if you have them, Warm Tops for the summit along with gloves & a hat as the summit can be very windy and cold even in summer, all carried in a Rucksack.

LOCATION & MEETING POINT

Parking is available just outside Edale in Barber Booth car park, from where the walk will commence. Below is the Post Code & Map Reference for the start. People can follow me up from Derby if you arrange with me beforehand – Details further on.
