

Our usual plan of events is limited due to current restrictions and school policies, but we have come up with some new ideas to keep the fun and pennies flowing. **Please take part in as many as you can** to help raise funds to purchase resources and fund events for the children. We have already agreed to fund musical instruments and more outdoor play equipment in the near future, and are looking at other options that the school are keen to fund to support student learning and the school experience.

Upcoming events:

Christmas jumper sale: we will be collecting pre-loved Christmas jumpers during the week of 15th



November, ready for an **after-school sale on Monday 30**th **November**, **and Tuesday 1**st **December** (if there is still stock left). Dig out your pre-loved Christmas jumpers and get ready to recycle and restock your wardrobe. Adults and children's jumpers welcome. There will be a **Christmas jumper day** for the children on the last day of term, so this is an excellent opportunity to grab a bargain for then. Jumpers will be sold for £1 for children's jumpers, and £2 for adult jumpers.

Santa letters: We are unable to hold our usual Christmas fair this year and so Santa's grotto will not be



available but instead we are offering Santa letters. We have secured a friendly contact at the North Pole who has promised to reply personally to Santa letters sent by your child via our school, and will include a small gift with the response. More details to follow.

Christmas raffle: We will be holding a Rainbow Hamper Christmas Raffle. Further information to follow





but there will be a non-uniform day on **Friday 26**th **November** in return for donations towards the raffle. Each class will be allocated a colour and asked to bring in items (any) of this colour for the hampers. Tickets will be on sale online, as they were with the Easter raffle. This not only reduces our event costs (as we don't need to purchase tickets) but makes it easier to run without having tickets and money travelling between home and school.

300 Challenge: Don't forget that we are still running our 300 challenge to celebrate the school's 300th birthday this year. Your child can complete 300 of anything and see if they can raise some sponsorship in the process. **This event finishes on 27th November**, so get thinking! Sponsorship money can be transferred into the PTFA bank account. Email us for details.
