Dear parents,

This term we are looking at the story 'The Friendship Bench' to help us describe a setting. The story takes place at the beach and is about how two children, Tilly and Flint, make friends.

Each term, we ask that children complete a homework task which is related to our topic. This task is something that the children can spend time on and then present before half term. We encourage children to work with you on their projects.

As our story takes place at the beach, we have a range of ideas of what your child could choose, as listed below. Your child is also welcome to link their project with other areas of learning across the wider curriculum:

- Build a model lighthouse
- Research a beach
- Visit a library and find some books about sea creatures
- Grow a plant (Science link)
- Visit a place of worship (RE)
- Build a structure (DT)
- Go for a walk in your local area and take photos / draw what you can see (Geography)

You can, of course choose to do another seaside project if you or your child have anything you would like to create, or indeed another project idea linked with the topics above.

The aim of the home learning project is to spend a little time each week over the next four weeks working on the project and bring the result into school on Monday 14<sup>th</sup> October. On Tuesday 15<sup>th</sup> October, straight after school, parents are invited into the school hall, where projects from all classes will be displayed for you to see in a 'Homework Showcase'.

We really hope you will enjoy working together and extending your child's learning school further.
