This half term, our class will be learning about the Stone Age based around our text, 'The Wild Way Home'.

To link in with our learning in Art and to extend the children's learning about life in Stone Age Britain, we are asking that the children produce a homework project based the following ideas.

They could perhaps:

1. Research and find out about a Stone Age monument in the UK. You can create a fact file, poster or even a mini version of the monument.
2. Create your own Stone Age jewellery.
3. Find out what brought the Stone Age period of history to an end. What came next?



These are a few ideas but above all, we want the children to enjoy independent learning.

Children can present the information they research in any way they wish but there should just be one outcome each which shows what they have learnt from their research.

The aim of the home learning project is to spend a little time each week over the next four weeks working on the project and bring the result into school on **Monday 15<sup>th</sup> October 2024**. **On Tuesday 15<sup>th</sup> October 2024**, straight after school, parents are invited into the school hall, where projects from all classes will be displayed for you to see in a 'Homework Showcase'.

We are asking parents to spend time with your child, sharing in the preparation and planning, talking together about what they are doing and providing encouragement and support.

We really hope you will enjoy working together and extending your child's learning at school further.
