


Dear Parents,



This half term, our class will be learning the Earth's biomes and discovering how different they are, using the book 'The Princess' Blankets. We will also be using the book 'Natural World' to help us in our learning. To extend the children's learning further, we are continuing home learning projects. This home style of learning aims to:

- Provide opportunities for children to be creative and choose how they record.
- Provide opportunities for children to work independently on self-study.
- Enable children to research an area of knowledge linked to the topic which interested them.

To extend the children's learning in these areas even further, here are so possible ideas to get you started:

- **Take a cutting from a plant to try to grow a new plant. Create a report / instructions / photo diary to document the process.**

- Create a 3D model / detailed artistic interpretation of one of the Earth's biomes.
- Create an in-depth fact file / presentation about one of the Earth's biomes.

But overall, enjoy independent learning in any way they choose.

Children can present the information they research in any way they wish but there should just be one outcome each which shows what they have learnt about from their research.

The aim of the home learning project is to spend a little time each week over the next four weeks working on the project and bring the result into school on **Monday 14th October 2025. On Tuesday 15th October 2024**, straight after school, parents are invited into the school hall, where projects from all classes will be displayed for you to see in a 'Homework Showcase'.

We are asking parents to spend time with your child sharing in the preparation and planning, talking together about what they are doing and providing encouragement and support.

We really hope you will enjoy working together and extending your child's learning at school further.
