As part of a wider curriculum opportunity, we would like your child to take part in 'Forest Schools'.

Forest Schools is an innovative educational approach to outdoor learning. The philosophy of Forest Schools is to encourage and inspire individuals of any age through positive experiences and participation in a range of tasks and activities, set in a woodland environment.

Forest Schools;

- Increases self-esteem and self-confidence,
- Improves co-operation, communication skills, and awareness of others,
- Increases motivation, self-discovery, and positive attitude toward learning,
- Encourages ownership and pride in the local environment,
- Encourages a better understanding of the outdoors
- Increases the skills and knowledge of the individuals that take part

It enables children to learn about the natural environment, how to handle risks, and to use their own initiative to solve problems and co-operate effectively with others.

The programme will take place for Class 4 pupils from Richardson Endowed Primary School at Horsley Woodhouse Primary School on the following afternoon dates:

Wednesday 25th June 2025

Wednesday 2nd July 2025

The children will be working in the school woodland in all weathers (except for high winds). Waterproof coats will be needed and if your child has them waterproof trousers are beneficial. We would be grateful if you could ensure your child **brings a change of suitable clothes that you don't mind getting dirty to change into**. Also, a pair of Wellington boots, for each session, is a must. Your child will need to bring a change of shoes to change into after the session.

The children will be having lunch at school at 12.00pm and then walking down to Horsley Woodhouse Primary School with staff. In the case of poor weather, sessions may need to be postponed but we envisage that with the correct outer weather wear, it will be safe and comfortable for all.
