This half term, our class will be exploring the environment and our new text: City of Rust.

To enhance the children's learning about our air pollution topic, 'Why is it important to preserve our environment?' we are asking that the children produce a homework project based on the following ideas.

- Design and craft their own-eco friendly house.
- Use artistic tools and skills to depict climate change.
- Write a report or create a digital presentation looking in depth into any area of this half term's curriculum that interests them.
- Make their own robot inspired by City of Rust to combat climate changes in their town.

The above are just a few examples and your child could come up with their own exciting idea. Above all, we would like the children to enjoy independent learning in any way they choose and be creative!

Children can present the information they research in any way they wish but there should just be one outcome each which shows what they have learnt about from their research.

The aim of the home learning project is to spend a little time each week working on the project and bring the result into school on **Monday 23rd February 2026**. On **Tuesday 24th February 2026**, straight after school, parents are invited into the school hall, where projects from all classes will be displayed for you to see in a 'Homework Showcase'.

We are asking parents to spend time with your child sharing in the preparation and planning, talking together about what they are doing and providing encouragement and support.

We really hope you will enjoy working together and extending your child's learning at school further.
