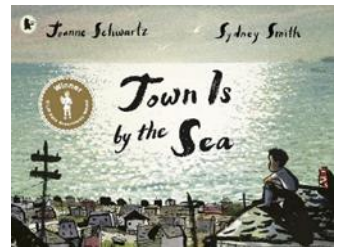

Our Learning

Our theme this half term is '**Social Justice**', and our topic is '**Why do the Richardson brothers deserve to be remembered?**'

English - Our core text for this half term is 'Town is by the Sea', by Joanne Schwartz. Within our writing lessons, we will be learning to write a short story, followed by writing our very own leaflet.



Maths – We will continue to learn about division structures before we move on to shape and adding and subtracting two-digit numbers.

History – Linked to the book we are reading in English; we will be learning about the Richardson Brothers and the history of our school.

Art – We will be learning how to create 3D sculptures out of clay.

Science – We will be continuing our learning about animals including humans, followed by living things and their habitats. This will involve lots of learning to be done outside!

PSHE – We will be learning about money and jobs within the community.

RE – We will be learning about how and why we celebrate special and sacred times.

Music – We will be inventing a musical story and learning about how music can teach us things about our neighbourhood.

Computing – We will be learning about and creating pictograms.

PE – Our lessons will continue taking place on a **Tuesday** and **Thursday**. Please ensure your child is in the correct PE kit, hair is tied up and earrings are removed at home. On Tuesdays we will be outside, playing invasion games and on Thursdays, for the first 3 weeks, we will be taking part in golf and followed on by team building skills.

Reading

We are continuing with our Little Wandle reading scheme. Your child will come home with a reading book each week. Please listen to your child read at home at least **three times a week** and we will change books on a **Friday**.

We are also continuing with our Little Wandle bridge to spelling unit and will keep re-teaching any phonics gaps identified.
