



Dear Parents,

This half term, our class will be continuing to learn about the Romans based around our text, 'Empire's End: A Roman Story'.

To link in with our learning in Art & DT and to extend the children's learning about life in Roman Britain, we are asking that the children produce a homework project based the following ideas.

They could perhaps:

- Create a model of a Roman shield, mosaic, chariot or famous building (e.g. the Colosseum).
- Create a Roman mosaic using different materials.
- Research and create a fact file about a Roman god or goddess.



These are a few ideas but above all, we want the children to enjoy independent learning.

Children can present the information they research in any way they wish but there should just be one outcome each which shows what they have learnt from their research.

The aim of the home learning project is to spend a little time each week working on the project and bring the result into school on **Monday 8th June 2026**. On **Tuesday 9th June 2026**, straight after school, parents are invited into the school hall, where projects from all classes will be displayed for you to see in a 'Homework Showcase'.

We are asking parents to spend time with your child, sharing in the preparation and planning, talking together about what they are doing and providing encouragement and support.

We really hope you will enjoy working together and extending your child's learning at school further.
