They could perhaps:

4. Write a leaflet on one of the London landmarks.



These are a few ideas but above all, we want the children to enjoy independent learning.

Children can present the information they research in any way they wish but there should just be one outcome each which shows what they have learnt from their research.

The aim of the home learning project is to spend a little time each week over the coming weeks working on the project and bring the result into school on **Monday 8<sup>th</sup> June 2026**. On **Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> June 2026**, straight after school, parents are invited into the school hall, where projects from all classes will be displayed for you to see in a 'Homework Showcase'.

We are asking parents to spend time with your child, sharing in the preparation and planning, talking together about what they are doing and providing encouragement and support.

We really hope you will enjoy working together and extending your child's learning at school further.
