This term, we are reading the story 'The Queen's Handbag' to help us understand our heritage. The book explores famous landmarks across the United Kingdom and the Queen's hat gets blown around the country.

Each term, we ask that children complete a homework task which is related to our topic. This task is something that the children can spend time on and then present. We encourage children to work with you on their projects.

As our book is all about the United Kingdom, we have chosen some homework ideas based on this as well as our learning in other curriculum areas. These are listed below:

- research or visit a city in the United Kingdom
- create a model of a landmark in the UK
- create some artwork in the style of Any Warhol
- keep a weather diary
- research the flags of the countries that make up the UK
- design and make a healthy meal with your family (also an Embark award!)

You can, of course, choose to do another project idea linked with the topics above.

Children can present the information they research in any way they wish but there should just be one outcome each which shows what they have learnt from their research.

The aim of the home learning project is to spend a little time each week working on the project and bring the result into school on **Monday 8th June 2026**. On **Tuesday 9th June 2026**, straight after school, parents are invited into the school hall, where projects from all classes will be displayed for you to see in a 'Homework Showcase'.

We really hope you will enjoy working together and extending your child's learning in school further.
