Welcome back Class 2. I hope you all had a lovely half term break. I can't believe this our last half term together; I know it's going to be a blast.

Our Learning

Our theme this term is '**Our World and Beyond**'. This topic aims to help children understand the links between the local community and the wider world. We continue with our topic 'How different is Pointe-À- Pierre to London?'

English – our core textbook is 'Coming to England' by Floella Benjamin. In English, we are going to be writing a setting description and poetry.

Maths – we will be learning about a range of mathematical concepts such as doubling and halving, measure and capacity.

Science – we will be carrying out scientific investigations using predictions.

Geography– linked to the book we are reading in English; we will be studying the human and physical features of Pointe-À-Pierre.

DT – we will be making sandwiches.

PSHE – we will be exploring growing and changing.

Music – we will be exploring songs which teach us about looking after our planet.

RE – we will be learning all about sacred places.

Computing – we will be learning programming and designing.

PE – there has been a **change** to our PE days. Class 2s PE will take place on a **Thursday** and **Friday**, this half term. Please can you continue to ensure your child is in the correct uniform, hair is tied up and any jewellery is removed at home.

Reading books will be changed on **Fridays**. Please aim to listen to your child read at least three times per week. This is fundamental for your child's progress and learning, enabling them to build their vocabulary and comprehension skills.

Phonics Screening

If your child is due to re-take the Phonics Screening Check, this will take place during the week commencing 8th June. The children are working very hard in preparation for this, both in whole-class lessons and in smaller group sessions. Relevant resources to support practice at home have been sent with each child.
