This term, we are reading the story 'The Queen's Handbag.' by Steve Antony. It is a lovely book about a swan who takes the Queen's Handbag and visits lots of different landmarks around the United Kingdom.

Each term, we ask that children complete a homework task which is related to our topic. This task is something that the children can spend time on and then present before half term. We encourage children to work with you on their projects.

As our key learning question this half term is 'What makes the United Kingdom so important?' below is a list of possible projects children may wish to create. There are also some suggestions which relate to our wider curriculum learning. Your own ideas are really appreciated too!

- create a model of a UK landmark
- design a poster / fact file about the United Kingdom
- create some artwork in the style of Andy Warhol
- keep a weather chart
- explore one or all of your five senses

The aim of the home learning project is to spend a little time each week over the next four weeks working on the project and bring the result into school on **Monday 16th June 2025**. On **Tuesday 17th June 2025**, straight after school, parents are invited into the school hall, where projects from all classes will be displayed for you to see in a 'Homework Showcase'.
