
As you are aware, there are several booster groups taking place that some children have been invited to after schools. With only 3 weeks to go until the children sit their SATs, it is important that we utilise any extra revision time now. There is also lots of material available via the SATs Companion website that children can access in their own time (not just what is set for homework).

As you know, at the end of Key Stage 2, Year 6 children are required to sit the national tests. The children are working hard towards these, and we continue to ask them to do their very best, as they always do. The SATs will take place during the week beginning the 12th of May.



Please see an outline of the subjects that your child will be learning about during their lessons this term:

Basing our work on the book 'The Arrival' by Shaun Tan. The children will also explore the Global theme of 'Our Heritage'.



In our English sessions, we will use the book as inspiration and will be writing to entertain. We will also be looking at Malala Yousafzai and her incredible courage, writing a report of her heroism. In Geography, we will study a region of North and South America. Our science learning will look at evolution and the human body. In Art, we will be drawing self-portraits. In Maths, we will be focusing on properties of shapes, and in particular angles, while also exploring position and direction. As always, please continue to ensure your child is confident with their recall of times tables and corresponding division facts - this is invaluable as a platform for helping them with their maths. We will also continue to focus on key number skills and fluency to provide a firm foundation in preparation for your child's transfer to secondary school.

In PE, children will be playing cricket and participating in fitness activities. Please send your child to school in their PE uniform on Monday and Thursday. In our PSHE lessons, children will

learn about the importance of mental well-being, as well as looking at changes that happen physically, mentally, and emotionally, as they are growing up. Please look out for a letter regarding our Sex Education unit. During RE, we will be learning about what it means to be a Muslim in Britain today. During our computing lessons, children will learn about 3D modelling and programming.

Thank you for your support with the homework projects - it was lovely to welcome parents to the after-school showcase to view the projects. There will be another project soon to complete the year, please look out for the information.
