Welcome back Class 2. I hope you all had a lovely break and are ready for the next half term in the lead up to Easter.




### Our Learning

Our topic this term is 'Social Justice', which aims to help children understand about key features within the local community.

English - our core text for this half term is 'Town is by the Sea', by Joanne

Schwartz. Within our writing lessons we will be learning to write a set of instructions followed by part of a short story.



Maths – continuing learning about multiplication and division, followed by length and height and mass, capacity and temperature.

History – linked to the book we are reading in English; we will be studying about the Richardson Brothers and the history of the school.

DT / food technology – making a sandwich.

Science – continuing learning about animals including humans, followed by living things and their habitats.

PSHE - learning about money and jobs within the community.

RE - learning about how and why we celebrate special and sacred times.

Music – recognising different sounds.

Computing – learning about and creating pictograms.
